I recently saw a statistic that only 11% of Christians read the Bible. This is somewhat astounding, yet I can believe it to be accurate based on my experience with people over the years. We deny ourselves great insight, wisdom and openness to His Spirit because we fail to seek Him where He has already given us Truth. As the Psalmist prayed to God, "Cause me to understand the way of Your precepts, that I may meditate on Your wonderful deeds. My soul is weary with sorrow; strengthen me according to Your word (Psalm 119:27-28)."

God created us in His image, and part of that image is the ability to communicate important ideas and messages throughout the ages through the spoken and written word. God communicated with us through His revealed word which was recorded in set of books that we know collectively as the Bible. This word of God is for our benefit, it enlightens, teaches, edifies, rebukes and warns us (Psalm 19:7-14). It is the best instrument that we have for understanding the "mind of God." Jesus told the parable of the Sower to instruct us that for true growth we have to not only hear the word of God, but also let it take root in our lives (see Luke 8:4-15). As you go deeper with the Lord, you must be intentional in allowing His word to go deep into your hearts and take root there. Selah.


Altar Guild Volunteers

COFFEE TO SUPPORT EL SALVADOR MISSION



Salvador. We support sustainable coffee growing and work directly with small farmers in El Salvador. The coffee beans are shipped here, then roasted in Georgia for maximum quality and freshness.

The cheerful, colorful artwork on our bags and products is the result of an art contest held at the La Magdalena Christian School. Winners' artwork is used, and reflects the hope for the bright future of the children of our school.

Coffee and products are available on Shopify - https://onechildcoffee.myshopify.com/ and can be shipped anywhere in the USA. We have both Medium and Dark Roast Ground and Whole Bean Coffee in 12 oz. bags. We also have short and long sleeve t-shirts, sweatshirts, and mugs.
