Overview of the OT and NT, foundational for any Christian who desires to know God through His Word!

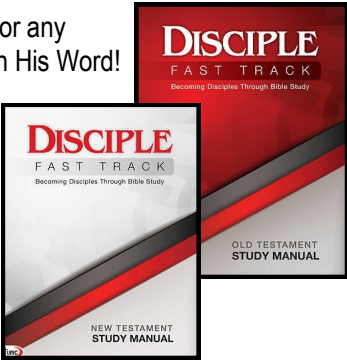

### Disciple 2, Into the Word into the World

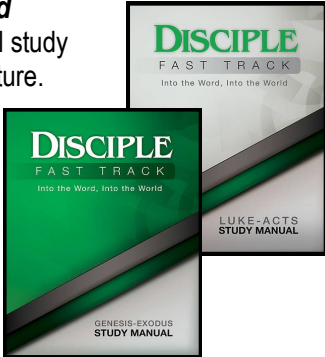
This study is designed to guide your personal study while deepening your understanding of Scripture.

### Epic of Eden-Understand the Old Testament-Updated Edition

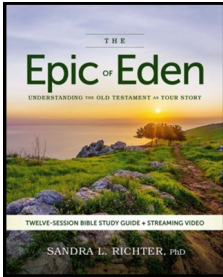

### Monday Night Bible Study

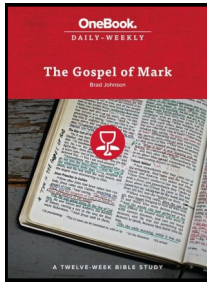

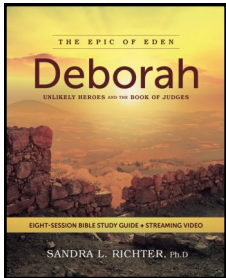
